



## Information on how to Bequest a donation through your Will or Estate

A bequest is a gift that you nominate in your Will.

Although you can draft your own Will, we recommend professional assistance from your own solicitor or one of the Trustee companies to ensure that your instructions are carried out exactly as you wish.

Should you decide to leave a gift to the Foundation, you may wish to choose the following wording:

"I Give and Bequeath to the Busselton Population Medical Research Foundation, C/-  
Department of Respiratory Medicine, Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital, Hospital Ave, Nedlands,  
Western Australia, ABN 58 366 731 760 in aid of that Institution and for its general purposes,  
free of all duties, the sum of \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
and/or Life Insurance Policy No. \_\_\_\_\_  
and/or the property situated at \_\_\_\_\_  
and/or my Residuary Estate for which the receipt of the Chairman or other authorised Officer  
shall be sufficient discharge"

It is of course entirely up to you whether you choose to disclose any details to us about your bequest, however it will help us to plan for the future. This advice would simply be a statement of your present intentions and is not in any way binding.
